

# **FALS Frenzy presented by Edelman Inc. set for October 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> at the Fairbury Speedway.**

Fairbury Speedway is excited to announce for the third year in a row, the fall classic is back with the FALS Frenzy presented by Edelman Inc. on Friday October 8<sup>th</sup> and Saturday October 9<sup>th</sup>.

The event will kick off with a camping reservations and fans allowed to enter the facility on Thursday October 7<sup>th</sup> at 4pm. Racing will heat up with complete shows in the Late Model's (5,000 to win), Modifieds (\$1,500 to win) and Pro-Crate Late Models (\$750 to win) on Friday October 8<sup>th</sup> and conclude on Saturday October 9<sup>th</sup>, highlighted by a 50 lap \$15,000 to win show for the Late Models, \$3,000 to win for the Modifieds and \$1,000 to win for the Pro-Crate Late Models.

## Blankets & Seating

Blankets may be put down for general admission seating on the front stretch main covered grandstands only at 2 p.m. on Friday October 9<sup>th</sup> for the weekend. Any blankets/seats put down before that time (unless authorized) will be taken down and placed near the closest stairs. There will be plenty of seats for the weekend. Reserved seating for the weekend will be marked with an orange dot. Any seat that has an orange dot on it has been reserved for the weekend. Additional rules and regulations for the FALS Frenzy seating:

- Stadium seats are NOT allowed in any sections of the bleachers or grandstands.
- No smoking or vaping in the bleachers or grandstands at any time!
- No coolers or bottles allowed in the bleachers or grandstands.
- Only FALS purchased cans and alcohol allowed in the bleachers or grandstands.
- Alcohol is prohibited in the pit area until the races are over for the evening.
- Fans are asked to print seat vouchers or have them available on their phones as proof of reserved seating.

Gates will open at **4pm** Thursday, October 7<sup>th</sup> to allow campers with reservations to secure their spots. Campers without reservations are free to come in at that time as well and will be directed to open spots or overflow camping. (ALL campers must be parked by 2pm Saturday afternoon, after 2pm, flags will be pulled for car parking in those spots).

### **BE PREPARED TO PURCHASE YOUR WEEKEND TICKET UPON ARRIVAL –**

Pit Passes will not be sold until 11am Saturday morning. If you are planning on getting a Pit Pass, you must purchase your GA ticket upon arrival, and you can upgrade to a pit pass when the pits open for business Saturday.

All Camping Reservations must enter 1<sup>st</sup> Street Main Entrance (GATE 1)

- Gate 1 will not close throughout the weekend and will be staffed. People entering or exiting the grounds that are a part of a camping spot must have their camping pass to re-enter the grounds. No-Exceptions! Camping passes will be handed out upon arrival for all camping reservations.
- Each Camping Lot Must have an RV/Trailer on it; no car/van/truck-only parking is allowed in Camping Lots.

### **Additional Camping Rules:**

- There are NO hookups for campers.
- Quiet generators are allowed. Quiet time for the weekday will be from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. (Thursday Night) - Quiet time for the weekend will be from 1 a.m. to 7 a.m. (Friday/Saturday Night)
- Campfires will be allowed **ONLY** in raised fire pits in reserved FALS Camping areas. Please dispose of your ashes in the metal barrels around the speedway grounds.
- Please dispose of your garbage in bags and the FALS Staff will be around daily to pick it up.
- Please be respectful of others around you at all times!

Failure to obey camping rules, regulations and respect for the fairgrounds will result in loss of privileges for future events.

## Gate Entrance Times:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Street Gate 1 opens on Thursday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, at 12 p.m. for all camping reservations to secure their spot. (Must pay for a weekend wristband \$50 upon arrival.)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Gate 2 will open at 11am Friday October 8<sup>th</sup> and Saturday October 9<sup>th</sup> for handicap parking and general admission ticket sales only. Limited car parking will be available at Gate 2.
- Race Car haulers must use 3<sup>rd</sup> street Pit Gate 3 all week leading up to the event!
- Pit Gate (3<sup>rd</sup> Street Only) will open up at 11 a.m. on Friday & Saturday. No cars will be allowed through this entrance at any time. No personal vehicles will be allowed to park in the pits.

For race car rigs travelling and arriving during the night late Thursday, haulers will use the main Pit Gate 3 on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. Race Teams will be parked upon arrival by speedway officials for maximum capacity for the weekend.

## Event Parking:

- FALS Frenzy event parking is free.
- For those without camping reservations, a spot must be reserved inside the grounds (if available) with a vehicle with no additional spots saved without a vehicle in them (NO CAUTION TAPE OR STAKES ALLOWED). These rules apply to everyone without exception.
- Additional parking will be available at no cost at the grade school to the west of the speedway.

## Additional Weekend Information:

- All credential requests must be sent to FALS owner, Matt Curl, prior to the FALS Frenzy weekend @ [fairburyspeedway@gmail.com](mailto:fairburyspeedway@gmail.com)
- Once credentials are approved, they will only be allowed to be picked up at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Gate 3 Pit Pass Building beginning at 11am. Friday October 8<sup>th</sup>.
- All vendors must pre-register for the FALS Frenzy Weekend. Cost for vending will be \$200 for the weekend.
- No unauthorized drones will be allowed on the grounds of the Fairbury Speedway at any time.
- FALS will not be responsible for the loss or damage of your property.
- Racing fuel will be available at the track each night
- FM Broadcast Channel 105.3 The Drive only available around the town of Fairbury.
- FALS Frenzy will be streamed live on FloRacing each night.

## Golf Cart Rules:

### General Rules That Apply Every Race Night

1. All drivers must be at least 16 years old.
2. No 4-wheeler or "gator" type vehicles are allowed outside of the pit area. GOLF CARTS ONLY in the general admission area.
3. General admission area and pit area vehicles are restricted to their respective areas after the pits are closed to the public.
4. A reasonable, slow (approximately 5 mph) speed limit will be enforced at all times.
5. No carts allowed between the backstretch bleachers and the fence, on the horse track in front of the grandstands, and anywhere posted "NO GOLF CARTS".

## Special Event Rules

1. All “general” rules apply.
2. All general admission area golf carts must be registered to be allowed on the property. A \$10.00 seasonal registration fee will apply for residents who possess a city of Fairbury sticker. A \$20.00 event registration fee will apply for those that are not a city of Fairbury resident. Golf cart stickers can be purchased at the 1<sup>st</sup> Street ticket gate 1 or on arrival for the weekend.
3. All golf carts not staying on the premises overnight will still need to be registered and must be parked in the designated areas outside gate 1 or gate 2 for general admission or in the designated area outside the 3rd street gate 3 for pit admission.
4. All general admission area golf carts must be parked on race nights from 5 p.m. until 1 hour after the races have concluded on non-race nights.
5. All pit area golf carts, 4-wheelers, etc. must be parked from 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last race until sunrise.
6. Special exemptions to the rules for special needs will be considered if applied for in writing in advance. Applications must be received by FALS at P.O. Box 165, Fairbury, IL 61739 at least 1 week prior to the event or email fairburyspeedway@gmail.com

Anyone violating the above rules may forfeit their right to operate their vehicle on our property and may be required to “load up” or remove their vehicle immediately at the discretion of the FALS officials.

- Late Models, Modifieds and Pro-Crate Late Models are unsanctioned for this weekend, Fairbury Speedway officials will be administering all registration, tech, rules, procedures and payouts. FALS will be using the DIRTcar Technical Rules for all classes
- No Entry Fees for any divisions for the FALS Frenzy
- Transponder Rental for each night is \$10.00 (FALS uses AMB Red Mylaps Transponders)
- Fairbury Speedway track rules will be in effect for the weekend
- Payout will be done after the night, drivers must have 1099 information filled out to get your paycheck

### **Tire Rules:**

**Late Model Tire Rule:** Hoosier LM 20 on (4) corners; Hoosier LM 30 or LM 40 option on RR ONLY; Grooving and Siping allowed on all tires. Drivers must same LF,RF, LR, RR tires throughout the night. Driver can Change 1 new RR before the Feature.

**Modified Tire Rule:** Hoosier E-Mod 26.5 or 27.5 M-30S on (4) corners; Hoosier M-60 option on RR only. NO GROOVING allowed... Siping allowed on ALL tires.

**Pro-Crate Late Models:** Hoosier LM 40 on (4) Corners; Grooving and Siping allowed on all tires.
